THE PROBLEM

The effects of climate change are already damaging community infrastructure, exacerbating pollution problems, shrinking our beaches, and diminishing the public's ability to enjoy coastal resources. Global sea level is projected to rise by six feet or possibly more by 2100. U.S. scientists estimate that about 50% to 70% of our coastlines are at high risk for 'beach loss' due to sea level rise and coastal erosion. Beach access and coastal recreation, which drive our tourism and recreation economies and contribute billions of dollars to coastal communities, are at dire risk. These changes threaten the very essence of what makes the ocean so special: its beauty, its biodiversity, and the coastal communities that depend on it.



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OUR VISION

The Surfrider Foundation's Climate Action Program empowers and supports chapters to restore and protect their coastlines and oceans, mitigating and adapting to climate change impacts and preserving coastal environments for future generations through the implementation of nature-based solutions. By focusing on nature-based solutions, we aim to conserve and restore critical carbon-storing coastal ecosystems, ensuring the resilience of our coastal environments and communities.
