



The Surfrider Foundation's Ocean Friendly Hotels Program recognizes hotels that are committed to reducing single-use plastic and offers a simple, straightforward framework to help them make sustainable choices for the ocean.

What does it take to be an Ocean Friendly Hotel?

- 1. No plastic beverage bottles or plastic bags.**
- 2. No expanded polystyrene (aka Styrofoam).**
- 3. Foodware and accessory items in rooms are reusable or made from naturally occurring materials and are not packaged in plastic.**
- 4. Toiletries are not packaged in small plastic bottles.**
- 5. Water refill stations are available for guests.**
- 6. If applicable, restaurants or cafes onsite are Surfrider Ocean Friendly Restaurants.**
- 7. Proper solid waste recycling procedures are followed and bins are provided for guest use.**

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
