What does it take to be an Ocean Friendly Hotel?

- 1. No plastic beverage bottles or plastic bags.
- 2. No expanded polystyrene (aka Styrofoam).
- 3. Foodware and accessory items in rooms are reusable or made from naturally occurring materials and are not packaged in plastic.
- 4. Toiletries are not packaged in small plastic bottles.
- 5. Water refill stations are available for guests.
- 6. If applicable, restaurants or cafes onsite are Surfrider Ocean Friendly Restaurants.
- 7. Proper solid waste recycling procedures are followed and bins are provided for guest use.
