

Ocean Friendly Restaurants Club Lead

Volunteer Position Description

The time commitment can vary from 2 to 6 hours a week. We ask for at least a 1-school year commitment if possible.

Responsibilities include:

- General oversight of your club's Ocean Friendly Restaurants (OFR) program including the promotion of the OFR program to your school cafeteria or eateries (if applicable) and local restaurants.
- Serving as the liaison between your club and the nearest chapter running an OFR program (if applicable).
- Recruit OFR volunteers, including building a list of volunteers and potential volunteers specifically for OFR.
- Scheduling and leading monthly, bi-monthly or quarterly OFR committee meetings and hosting social events at your best OFRs.
- Schedule and host at least one OFR Ambassador Training per year where you teach volunteers how to approach restaurants and sign them up for an OFR Membership.
- Manage database or list of potential restaurants to approach for an OFR Membership.
- Contribute content for the club's social media pages .
- Using the ofr@yourclub.surfrider.org email address for chapter related emails .
- Conduct compliance checks for new and renewing OFRs
- Many of these responsibilities can be delegated to other volunteers in the OFR committee but it is the duty of the OFR Lead to make sure they get done.
