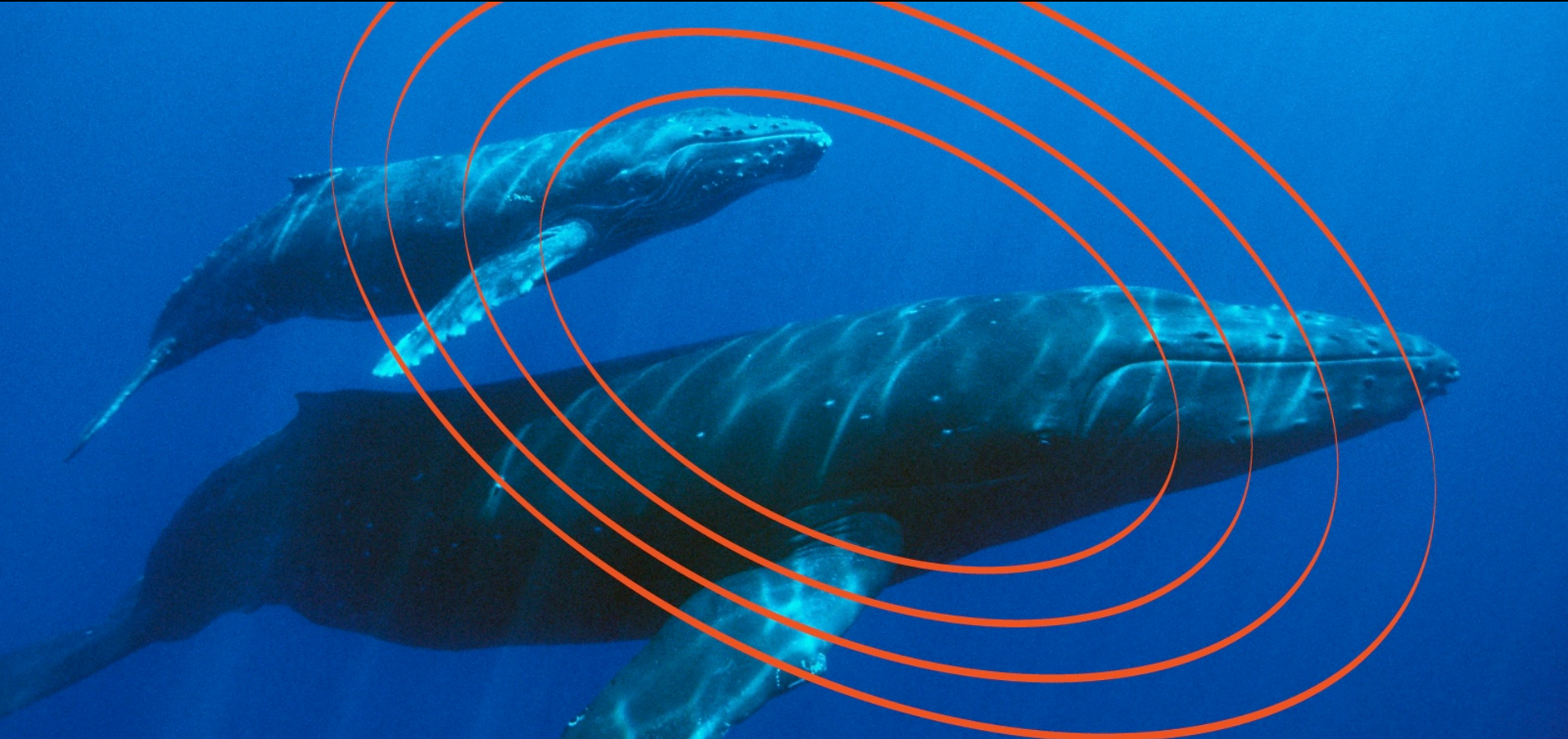

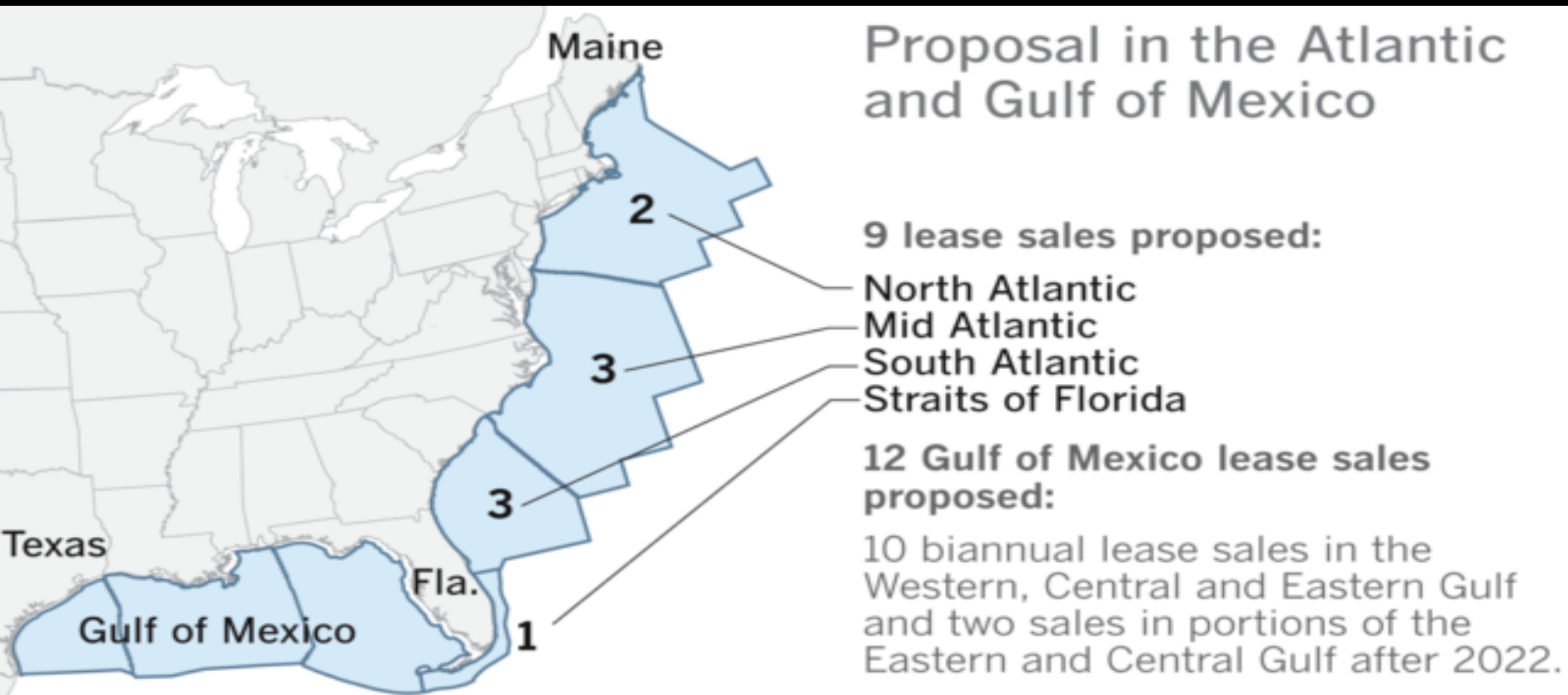



**Offshore Oil Drilling 2017-2018**



The Trump administration has announced a proposal to expand offshore oil drilling in U.S. waters, threatening ocean recreation, tourism and fishing industries. The Draft Proposed Five-Year OCS Offshore Oil and Gas Leasing Plan released by the Interior Department includes planned drilling in the Atlantic, Pacific, Gulf of Mexico, and Arctic Ocean. This extreme proposal opens over 90% of the Outer Continental Shelf to new drilling and puts our nation's coastal communities, beaches, surf breaks, and marine ecosystems at risk of a catastrophic oil spill. **OUR COASTS ARE UNDER THREAT**



The Trump administration has announced plans to expand offshore oil drilling to over 90% of U.S. waters. The Draft Proposed Plan for 2017-2020 allows for the 200,000+ acre offshore oil and gas lease sale in the Atlantic, Pacific, Gulf of Mexico, and Arctic Ocean. The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) is accepting public comments on applications for all the areas across the four coastal regions.
